Additional Information

To help you more easily integrate your QuarkCopyDesk SE and QuarkXPress™ workflows, the QuarkCopyDesk SE CD-ROM includes two QuarkXTensions™ modules that can be installed with QuarkXPress and QuarkXPress Passport™: the QuarkCopyDesk Filter and the Notes QuarkXTensions software.

The QuarkCopyDesk Filter lets you import text from QuarkCopyDesk SE articles into QuarkXPress documents, in addition to letting you save QuarkXPress text in QuarkCopyDesk format.

The Notes QuarkXTensions software provides QuarkXPress users with the facility to attach notes to QuarkCopyDesk SE Articles and Templates. Users who load the Notes QuarkXTensions software can read, enter and edit these notes in text.

You can find these QuarkXTensions modules in the “For QuarkXPress” folder on the QuarkCopyDesk SE CD-ROM. For installation instructions, see the “ReadMe.pdf” document included with each module.

Problems Fixed in this Version

Using QuarkXPress

- QuarkCopyDesk SE 2.2 now allows you to export an anchored box created in QuarkXPress to QuarkCopyDesk SE, and import it back into QuarkXPress. In previous versions, this sequence caused the QuarkXPress application to quit.
- In earlier versions, the QuarkCopyDesk SE application quit when you chose **Update Geometry**. This problem has been fixed.
- Windows only: When you opened a QuarkXPress document, containing a modified style sheet, in QuarkCopyDesk SE, the software quit. This problem has been fixed.

Using QuarkDMS

- Creating an anchored text box containing text within another text box, checking the text box into QuarkDMS™ as a QuarkCopyDesk SE document, and then dragging and dropping the text box from the **Query** palette into a new QuarkXPress document, created an empty anchored text box. The problem has been fixed in this version.
- Windows only: QuarkCopyDesk SE 2.2 now allows you to open **XPress Tags** asset choosing **Edit With Application** command in the **Query** palette. Previously, choosing **Edit with Application** from the context menu displayed the tags in the new article as plain text.

Using Auxiliary Dictionary

In earlier versions, the QuarkCopyDesk SE application quit if you tried accessing an auxiliary dictionary after closing a new article. The problem has been fixed in this version.

Display Problem

Selecting **Swedish** as the program language and choosing **Help → About QuarkCopyDesk SE Passport** with the Ctrl key pressed displayed “QuarkCopyDesk” twice in the title bar. The problem has been fixed in this version.

Using Spell Check

- Choosing the **Check Spelling** command with a locked auxiliary dictionary caused the QuarkCopyDesk SE application to quit. The problem has been fixed in this version.
- Using the **Check Spelling** command after deleting an auxiliary dictionary caused the QuarkCopyDesk SE application to quit. The problem has been fixed in this version.
- Using the **Check Spelling** command on a long word caused the QuarkCopyDesk SE application to quit. The problem has been fixed in this version.

Installing QuarkCopyDesk SE

- During the installation of QuarkCopyDesk SE, when you reached the **Confirm User Information** screen, then returned to the initial screen using the **Go Back** button, and returned to the **Registration Information** screen, the word "regaddr_" was prefixed to the values entered in **Title**, **Middle Name**, **Organization**, and **Department** fields. The problem has been fixed in this version.
- International English (IE) edition: In the earlier versions of QuarkCopyDesk SE, **United States** was the default selection in the **Country** pop-up menu. The problem has been resolved in this version.
- QuarkCopyDesk SE 2.2 now displays an online registration form at the end of installation. In the earlier versions of QuarkCopyDesk SE, the online registration form did not display at the end of installation.

Known Issues

Saving Templates

Mac OS only: While saving a QuarkCopyDesk SE template created from an exported article, an alert displays stating that file has not been found.

Using QuarkXPress

- Components exported from QuarkXPress to a QuarkCopyDesk article do not display in the correct order in WYSIWYG view.
- If you create Bézier anchored boxes with a background color in a QuarkXPress document and export the document into QuarkCopyDesk SE, only solid rectangles display and the Bézier shapes are lost when you print the document.
- If you attempt to anchor a picture box containing a picture within the text, an empty anchored picture box displays when you open the article in QuarkCopyDesk SE.
- If a QuarkXPress document containing pictures and text is exported to QuarkCopyDesk SE and then printed, pictures on the first page do not print.
- When you create a QuarkXPress document containing multiple notes and then paste the text, including notes, on a master page, the notes display on the document pages, but not on the master page.
- QuarkCopyDesk SE quits if you try to undo a **Create List** process in a QuarkCopyDesk SE article.

- If a document containing anchored picture boxes with colored backgrounds is exported from QuarkXPress to QuarkCopyDesk SE, the second instance of an anchored picture box with a background prints black from QuarkCopyDesk SE.
- The superior attribute in a style sheet does not display in the style sheet even when it is checked in the **Type Style** frame.
- A read only **XPress Tags** file does not open in QuarkCopyDesk SE.

Mac OS only

- If you create a table with a note in one of the cells in QuarkXPress, export it as a multiple-component article, and then save it as a QuarkCopyDesk SE article, the table does not display properly when you open the article in QuarkCopyDesk SE.
- The **Notes** menu displays font types instead of items when Adobe Type Reunion is loaded.
- If pages with open notes are rearranged in the **Layout** palette, open notes do not redraw correctly.
- Choosing **Page** → **Go to page** and viewing a document with 100% view (choosing **View** → **Fit in Window**), does not redraw notes correctly.

Windows only

- If you create a QuarkXPress document and save it as a QuarkCopyDesk SE article, it does not display properly when you open it and save it as an RTF file.
- The shortcut for closing a note is the same as that for closing a document.

Using Notes QuarkXTensions Software

- Mac OS only: Using the Notes QuarkXTensions software with QuarkXPress causes redraw problems on master pages.
- Inserting a note with a large font size truncates the text of the note when viewed in galley and full screen views. As a workaround, minimize and maximize the application window.

Using TypeTricks

The **Make Price** command is not available when you place the insertion bar (\int) on a numerical figure involving multiple radices. As a workaround, select the complete numerical figure when using multiple radices.

Using WordPerfect

Mac OS only: An article created and saved in QuarkXPress displays junk characters when opened in WordPerfect. This is only a display problem, however.

Using QuarkCopyDesk Installer

Windows only: If you run the QuarkCopyDesk SE Passport installer with the Italian language selected, the online registration form does not display correctly after the installation is completed.

Documentation Issues

QuarkCopyDesk SE 2.2 Addendum, “Layers” Chapter 1, “QuarkXPress 5.01 Features” erroneously mentions that QuarkCopyDesk SE supports layers exported from QuarkXPress.

Compatibility Issues

Problem

Text inset differences may cause reflow. Articles created in QuarkCopyDesk SE have a text inset of 0 points, while the default text inset for a text box in QuarkXPress or QuarkXPress Passport is 1 point. Because of this, text may reflow when a QuarkCopyDesk SE article is imported to QuarkXPress.

Workaround

Create a text box with the desired text inset in QuarkXPress and export it as a QuarkCopyDesk SE article using the QuarkCopyDesk Filter.
